recent times we often come across the word "cluster" not only in the field of economics, but also in pedagogy. What concept, meaning is this word, which is mentioned by the head of state by bot-bot, about what its essence consists of, Maruf Tashpulatov spoke in his article as follows: "cluster - derived from the English word "cluster", which in translation means such meanings as group, ball, set, garden. The study of the existing shortcomings in the educational system of the Tashkent region and their analysis showed that the Coordination of pedagogical Educational Directions, planning of prospects, the slowness of communication and integration between educational stages, the prevalence in the activities of educational subjects caused a lack of satisfaction of the need for pedagogical personnel in the area and a decrease in the quality Based on this, the Institute defined a new system related to the creation of an innovation cluster of pedagogical education in the Tashkent region as its priority strategic direction ... . The innovation cluster of pedagogical education is a whole set of all types of education in the system of continuing education, scientific research institutes and centers, practice bases, scientific and scientific-methodological structures, the activities of which are divided into joint tasks make it possible to raise the pedagogical education system to a qualitatively new level. Consequently, the main goal of the cluster is to combine the Educational-Scientificinnovative potential that is part of it not only with a high level of civil and professional competence, but also for the training of modern educational specialists with competitiveness, the ability to receive innovations, the ability to design and implement new educational programs and technologies. The cluster system of development of pedagogical education operates in general areas related to education, the creation of educational literature, the increase in the scientific potential of pedagogical personnel, the continuity of education and upbringing. At the moment, these general directions are the management and organization of education, the continuity between the types and directions of Education.

In order to fill the points highlighted above, we want to dwell on how the word "cluster" is gaining importance in the educational system of Europe, or rather, Germanspeaking countries, in what sense it is used: 1. CLUSTER is an abbreviation (short words), which means "English-"Cooperation link between Universities of Science and Technology for Education and Research - cooperation in education and research between scientific and technological universities". Under this name are 12 European Technical Universities, as well as 3.000 professors operating in them, 11.000 academics, 3.000 doctoral students, more than 14.000 students were united for collaborative purposes. Schulcluster (School cluster)- a school and higher educational institution can work together, preparing each other for various purposes: training teachers with mature knowledge, preparing students for the process of studying at the University, and supporting the research carried out directly in the course processes. The Technical University of Munich, on the basis of this concept, United a number of territorial schools into a single network, a system that later became popular and began to be called by the term Schulcluster (Schulklaster). The first step to organize this is the establishment of a base school, which serves as a coordinator, for which the address of the permanent application is the same OTM. This OTM, in turn, acts as a multiplier within the cluster. On a cluster scale, a number of educational institutions converge and interconnect their resources. In addition to educational institutions, extracurricular institutions (employment centers, training centers, etc.), local industrial enterprises and various social associations can also be added. In this way, schools in the same area will accelerate their interaction and the university will achieve an effective organization of communication with them without aggravating organizational issues. Events held by the OTM on a long territory are considered more profitable. The initial was organized by the Munich Technical University on November 16, 2007, combining 4 gymnasiums at Berchtesgadener land. Over time, 13 other schools in the nearby area were also added.
